### WELCOME TO ISRAEL

# Day 2 A TASTE OF TEL AVIV

Breakfast at hotel.

Private culinary tour in Tel Aviv's Levinsky Market with our local culinary expert. Experience one of Tel Aviv's colorful open-air markets. Sample a variety of local specialties, meet the vendors and hear their stories, and learn about the cultural food mosaic that is Israeli cuisine.

# Day 3 MEDITERRANEAN WINE AND CHEESE

Breakfast and check out from hotel.

Depart Tel Aviv and travel north along the coast

Walk through the excavations of the port city of Caesarea. Explore the excavations at the ancient city, including the architectural wonders of the Roman theater and aqueduct built by King Herod 2000 years ago, and enjoy the reconstructed port, now a cultural and culinary hot-spot. Perhaps enjoy lunch at one of the sea-side restaurants accompanied by the breeze off the Mediterranean Sea.

Wine has been part of the local tradition since Biblical times. Begin your exploration of Israeli wine with a visit to a **boutique winery** to hear their stories and enjoy a variety of local wines.

Stop at a **family goat farm**, nestled in the hills of Galilee away from city life, to meet the people and sample the wonderful homemade organic cheeses they create.

### ADVENTURES IN THE GOLAN HEIGHTS

#### Breakfast at hotel

Ascend to the **Golan Heights** for an overview of the region from the top of **Mount Bental**. Board your **jeep** for an off-road adventure along Israel's northern Border. Our local specialist will share perspectives about life in the Golan Heights and discuss the significance of the region.

Visit an **olive press** to learn about the ancient secrets of making olive oil including a tasting, or explore the local **fruit farms** with an opportunity to pick some seasonal fruit.

Stop in at a micro-brewery to sample local beer or even at a local distillery which has recently begun producing whiskey, both flavored with the cool mountain water of the Golan Heights.

Home hospitality dinner with a family in Galilee. Enjoy a sumptuous dinner prepared by a local family, a unique opportunity to meet with Israelis in their home.

### **GALILEAN TREATS**

### Breakfast at hotel

Participate in a hands-on cooking workshop and lunch in Galilee with Arab hosts. Our Arab cooking workshops invite you to participate in a hands-on, true to life cultural immersion. We have Druze, Moslem and Christian hosts who warmly welcome guests into their homes. This is a unique opportunity to learn to make local fare and experience a slice of Galilean village life.

In the mystical city of **Safed**, birthplace of Kabbala, meander through the narrow alleys leading to ancient synagogues and artists' quarters. The old city is the perfect spot to enjoy a coffee or tea with a Galilean treat, while soaking up the spiritual atmosphere and marveling at the sweeping vistas.

### FROM GALILEE TO JERUSALEM

Breakfast and check out from hotel

Explore some of the historical sites around the **Sea of Galilee**, each with a story to tell.

Visit the ancient synagogue of **Capernaum**, located on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

Visit the first century fishing village of Magdala, the home of Mary Magdalene, with ruins of the ancient synagogue and a new church built on the site, simple in design but rich in mosaics and murals.

Before leaving the Galilee, you might want to try a traditional St. Peter's Fish lunch, on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

Continue on to the city of **Nazareth**, boyhood home of Jesus and now a bustling Arab city. This is the perfect opportunity to try some classic Middle Eastern treats including strong, black coffee and *Knafe*, a sweet local classic prepared with shredded filo dough and cheese, all laced with a rose-water syrup.

Continue up to **Jerusalem** for your first glimpse of the City of Gold. Overnight Jerusalem





### LAYERS OF JERUSALEM

#### Breakfast at hotel

Start your exploration of Jerusalem at the **Mount of Olives**. Enjoy a panoramic overview of Jerusalem, the holy city to three faiths, drawing Jewish, Christian and Muslim Pilgrims for generations.

The over 3,000 year old **City of David** is one of the largest ongoing excavations in Israel. The Royal Secrets invites you to explore the site with a local specialist and see areas that are not yet open to the public. The digs have revealed preserved ancient fruit and vegetable seeds, including eggplant seeds from 1,100 years ago.

Private culinary tour in Jerusalem's Machaneh Yehuda Market with our local culinary expert. Experience Jerusalem's colorful open-air market. Sample a variety of local specialties, meet the vendors and hear their stories, and learn about the cultural food mosaic that is Israeli cuisine. Purchases in hand, the Israeli cuisine adventure continues in the kitchen as you learn to prepare local dishes and enjoy them together —with a nice glass of Israeli wine!

This evening we suggest a walk through Machaneh Yehuda after dark to experience the market's night life.

### THE SALT WONDER

### Breakfast at hotel

Journey through the Judean Desert to the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth. Visit Qumran, site of the secluded caves where the Dead Sea scrolls were first discovered. Drive past the orchards bearing dates, worth their weight in gold during biblical times. Ride the cable car to discover King Herod's mountain-top fortress at Masada, the last stronghold and stand of the Zealots against Rome, on the edge of the barren Judean Desert. Enjoy the therapeutic qualities of the Dead Sea. Float on the salty waters, relax and enjoy the facilities and lunch on site. We have confirmed day-use rooms for you at a local resort hotel. ### FLAVORS OF ISRAEL

#### Breakfast at hotel

Explore the insular neighborhoods of the ultra-Orthodox Jewish communities in Jerusalem to learn about their customs and traditions, dating back hundreds of years.

Roll up your sleeves as you knead and braid, learning the traditions of **Hallah baking** at the home of a local Jerusalem family.

Enjoy traditional generous **Arab hospitality** in a pastoral village outside Jerusalem. Meet with a local family in their home to share their stories and homemade cooking.

This evening we propose a dinner at one of our suggested restaurants overlooking the Old City.

### **Day 10**

### MEMORY AND MODERNITY

### Breakfast at hotel

Share in a meaningful private escorted visit to Yad Vashem, Israel's official Holocaust museum, dedicated to the memory of the victims and honoring the survivors. The visit is enriched with a pause at the moving Children's Memorial and a walk along the inspirational Avenue of the Righteous. The Israel Museum is the country's national gallery. Explore the compound, including the Model of Jerusalem from Second Temple Period and the Dead Sea Scrolls exhibited in the Shrine of the Book. Wander through the Billy Rose Sculpture Garden.

Take your Israel wine experience to the next level with an exclusive, intimate encounter with Israel's Wine Master. While sipping wine and taking in the view of the vineyard, follow the story of wine in Israel and its pursuit of excellence through perfection.

As the sun sets over the city, join in a **traditional Shabbat dinner** at the home of a local Jerusalem family, featuring ethnic dishes, prayer and song.

### DELIGHTS OF THE OLD CITY

#### Breakfast at hotel

Enter the Old City via Jaffa Gate. Climb along the ramparts of the Old City walls for a bird's eye view of life within and outside the walls. Walk along the 2,000 year old stones of the Cardo, the ancient Roman marketplace in the heart of the Old City. View the Temple Mount, site of the Al Aksa Mosque and Dome of the Rock.

While exploring the Old City, be sure to sample the fresh baked Jerusalem "bagele" with fragrant "zaatar" spice for dipping. Try the fresh squeezed pomegranate juice or the sweet "sahlab" poured out by the local vendor from the kettle on his back.

Walking through the Old City, we are drawn to the **Western Wall**, the holiest site in the Jewish tradition. The ancient Kotel now gathers people from around the world in prayer and celebration.

Indulge yourself with an authentic **Middle Eastern lunch** in the Old City, as an array of fresh, colorful salads are placed before you, featuring Humous and oven-baked pita bread.

Walk in the footsteps of Jesus along the final Stations of the Cross along the **Via Dolorosa** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, traditional site of the crucifixion.

This evening we propose a festive farewell dinner at one of our suggested chef restaurants, ending your journey with good food and fine wine.
